Nevada Man Wins Lottery

Las Vegas Sun, 1 April 2009 – Although Nevada has long spurned a state lottery, California lottery officials announced today that a Nevada resident, Steve Z. Waldman, 59, has won today's Super Lotto drawing worth \$33.0 million.

Contacted at his home in Las Vegas, Mr. Waldman acknowledged that a friend had bought him the winning ticket, and said, "I'm immediately announcing a cash prize of \$10,000 for the overall winner of the Nevada Open Road Challenge this coming May." Mr. Waldman claimed to be the president of the Silver State Classic Challenge organization that puts on the event, a car race from Ely to Las Vegas held twice a year. He said he would soon post more details concerning the new prize on the organization's website, and then he declined further comment.
